#### **Drug Testing Procedure**

The drug testing must be conducted by a certified laboratory, as outlined by the United States Department of Health and Human Services or any other laboratory designated by agreement of the parties.

\* Please note that we will still accept results from Alere Toxicology.

**STEP 1:** Choose a certified laboratory that can perform the <u>10 panel drug test</u> to test for the drugs at the initial test level nanogram/milliliter listed below.

Amphetamines	500
Barbiturates	300
Benzodiazepines	300
Cocaine	300
Methadone	300
Opiates	2000
Phencyclidine (PCP)	25
Propoxyphene (Darvon)	300
THC (marijuana and cannabinoids)	50
Methaqualones	300

STEP 2: Set up an account if necessary, and contact the collection site to set up the drug test and billing.

**FEES:** You will be charged a collection fee as well as a charge for the sample to be reviewed, both billed to you (the contractor).

All drug test results will be forwarded directly to you, so you are responsible for forwarding the results to the JATC office.

# \*The JATC requires submitted results that list all 10 drugs tested, as well as the levels they were tested for.

All drug tests are only good for 6 months from the date they are taken at the Lab.

A positive drug test can be retaken and resubmitted to the JATC no earlier than 6 months from the positive drug test.
